1. DEADLINE for Foundation scholarship applications is Wednesday, March 31, 2010, 5:00 p.m. (no exceptions). The applications and supporting documents must be received in the mail by this date.
2. Three (3) scholarships each in the amount of \$2,000.00 are available to assist with tuition, dormitory fees and textbook expenses that students incur while attending accredited post-secondary educational institutions will be awarded.
3. The three (3) scholarships will be awarded to three recipients (Wesfam team member or Wesfam employee's dependent child) who meet the eligibility requirements outlined below.
4. Eligibility requirements:

Team members must be an active team member of Wesfam Restaurants, Inc. and work an average of 15 hours per week. The applicant must have started work at Wesfam on or before October 1, 2009 and must have worked continuously through May 31, 2010. The applicant must have received a high school diploma or GED certificate by the end of the 2009-2010 school year. Employees can also be high school graduates already attending college.

Employee's children must be the dependent child of a Wesfam employee. The employee must have started work at Wesfam on or before October 1, 2009 and work an average of 15 hours or more per week. The applicant must have received a high school diploma or GED certificate by the end of the 2009-2010 school year. Employee child can also be high school graduates already attending college.
5. Incomplete application will be returned to you. Supporting documents required are:
 - Official high school or college transcript
 - Recommendation forms (required two (2))
 - Personal resume' (suggested)
6. If any question does not apply to you in this application please put N/A in the space.
7. Type or print legibly. Illegible applications will be returned to you.
8. All information submitted through the application process will be treated with the utmost security. Application material will not be returned.
9. The scholarship award decision will be based on each applicant's academic record, work record, school and community activities and school, work and community recommendation.
10. The scholarship selection committee will be composed of community leaders who are not employees of Wesfam Restaurants, Inc.
11. You will be notified by mail in May regarding the status of your application.
